2010 Sojourn Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon Proprietary Cuvée

A Cabernet Sauvignon Dry Red table wine from Napa, North Coast, California USA

My favorite of this trio is the 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Proprietary Red (only 150 cases produced), which is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from three vineyard sources. It possesses 14.8% natural alcohol. A deep purple color is followed by aromas of creme de cassis, incense, graphite, toasty oak and forest floor. Full-bodied and rich with terrific intensity, it should drink well for 15+ years.

These are three high quality, reasonably priced Cabernet Sauvignons from Sojourn, which is probably better known for its collection of Pinot Noirs from the Sonoma Coast.

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2010 Sojourn Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon Beckstoffer Vineyard George III

A Cabernet Sauvignon Dry Red table wine from Rutherford, Napa, North Coast, California USA

A wonderful effort, the 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Beckstoffer George III Vineyard is 100% unfined and unfiltered Cabernet Sauvignon that was aged in 75% new French oak. It achieved 14.7% alcohol. Abundant minerality along with incense, creme de cassis and toasty oak characteristics are found in this full-bodied, fleshy, nicely layered Cabernet along with beautiful purity, wonderful fruit and surprising accessibility for a 2010. It should drink well for 10-15 years.
