

**2013 Sojourn Cellars
Durell Vineyard Chardonnay
Sonoma Coast, California**

A steely, mineral-dominated white, the 2013 Chardonnay Durell Vineyard was made from the Old Wente clone and was aged in 40% new oak. A pebbly, rocky minerality along with notes of white peaches, honeysuckle and a subtle touch of roasted nuts emerge from this full-bodied, complex, impressively endowed, multilayered wine. It is capable of evolving for 5-6 years.

Wohler Vineyard Pinot Noir
Russian River Valley, California**

The 2013 Pinot Noir Wohler Vineyard reveals beautiful, sweet, Volnay-like strawberry and wild berry fruit, a lush, hedonistic texture, medium to full body and good purity. It was made from clones 115, 828 and the Wadenswil clone planted in deep Goldridge soils as it is the only Russian River selection in the Sojourn portfolio. With excellent depth and medium to full body, this big-time winner should drink well for 6-9 years.

Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon
Napa Valley, California**

From Napa, the 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Oakville possesses a dense ruby/purple color, a complex nose of forest floor, licorice, baking spices, Christmas fruitcake, blackberries and cassis intermixed with hints of coffee as well as oak. This full-bodied, supple textured, velvety, showy Cabernet Sauvignon should drink well for 10-15+ years.

Ridgetop Vineyard Pinot Noir
Sonoma Coast, California**

The deep ruby/plum-colored 2013 Pinot Noir Ridgetop Vineyard exhibits notes of forest floor, black cherries and wild berries. Fashioned from clones 115, 667 and 777, it is elegant, pure, medium-bodied and concentrated, but never heavy or overbearing. Drink now-2021.

**2013 Sojourn Cellars
Proprietary Cuvée
Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley**

POINTS

The 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Proprietary Cuvée is a blend of fruit from both Napa Valley hillside and valley floor vineyards. Complex notes of cedarwood, fruitcake, black cherries and blackcurrants intermixed with a whiff of subtle oak are found in this medium to full-bodied, red. Revealing impeccable integration of acidity, wood and tannin, it can be drunk now or cellared for 10-15 years.
