2014 Sojourn Cellars Durell Vineyard Chardonnay Sonoma Coast

The 2014 Chardonnay Durell Vineyard, which sees 40% new French oak, comes from very old Wente clones of Chardonnay. The 2014 has a beautiful white currant, quince, tangerine oil and lemon blossom nose, medium to full-bodied flavors, slightly more complexity and concentration than Sojourn's Sangiacomo Vineyard Chardonnay, and a longer finish. This is a beauty to drink over the next 7-8 years.
