2014 Sojourn Cellars Wohler Vineyard Pinot Noir Russian River Valley

I tasted three Pinot Noirs from Sojourn. The 2014 Pinot Noir Wohler Vineyard comes from a vineyard in the heart of Russian River Valley, planted with Dijon clones 667, 115, 828, and of course, the Wadenswil clone, which is California is called 2A. Lovely black and red currant fruit, some cherries, delicate spice box and earth are all present in this medium ruby-colored wine, which cuts a broad swatch across the palate. The acidity is present, the tannins ripe, and the wine generous, round and juicy. Drink if over the next 5-6 years.
