2014 Sojourn Cellars Reuling Vineyard, Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir

14.4% alc., 275 cases, \$69. This vineyard is located between Graton and Forestville. Heritage clones are planted in Goldridge soils.

Moderately reddish purple color in the glass. Heady aromas of black cherry, sous-bois, woodland and nutty oak. Both fruity and savory on the velvety palate, with flavors of black cherry and dark red raspberry enhanced with a light touch of toasty oak. A subtle savory herbal imprint runs in the background. Juicy, with noticeable but tame tannins and impressive length on a finish that is reluctant to give up.
