Deep ruby color; intense, complex aromas of cherry and leather with meaty notes; mouthfilling flavors of stewed cherry, leather and earth; very complex, great texture; great structure and balance; long finish. Intense, deep Pinot with so many interesting flavors and nuances. Really needs some air and time in the bottle to fully develop.

Sonoma Coast**

Deep ruby color; very complex, deep herb and cherry aromas; complex and very deep, mouthfilling cherry flavors with rich, asian spice notes and sweet oak; great structure and balance; long finish. Incredibly deep and layered; delicious now but will definitely reward some age.

Deep ruby color; big, complex earthy and forest floor aromas; deep, complex, cherry flavors with layers of forest floor and earthy notes; good structure and balance; long finish. Big, complex, earthy Pinot that screams for a dish with mushrooms.

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### About Our Tastings

We taste wine in flights of usually no more than 12 wines.  
All tasting unless otherwise noted is done blind by the Editor.

The tasting coordinator (who does not taste) arranges and bags all wines, which are then scored and comments recorded before bags are removed.  
Our tastings are done under controlled, consistent conditions.

Here is **PinotReport's 100-point scale**:

<b>96-100</b>	<b>SUPERIOR</b> ; it doesn't get better.
<b>90-95</b>	<b>OUTSTANDING</b> ; approaching the best
<b>86-89</b>	<b>ABOVE AVERAGE</b> ; a good Pinot.
<b>80-85</b>	<b>AVERAGE</b> ; OK if it's all you have.
<b>60-79</b>	<b>BELOW AVERAGE</b> ; not recommended.
<b>50-59</b>	<b>UNDRINKABLE</b> .
