Erich is the full-time winemaker at Audelssa Estate Winery in Glen Ellen. The duo decided to start Sojourn Cellars to create, at first, handcrafted Cabernet Sauvignon. They have since branched out to Pinot Noir and their 2005s follow on the heels of a delicious 2004 Pinot. These are deep, complex and incredibly well balanced Pinots and you should make sure that they are on your short list of wines to watch.

WOW! This Pinot has great structure and yet some of the most lush, juicy cherry fruit I've had in a while. Amazing Pinot from Sojourn Cellars.
