2014 Sojourn Cellars Sangiacomo Vineyard Chardonnay Sonoma Coast

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POINTS

The 2014 Chardonnay Sangiacomo Vineyard only sees 30% new French oak, and displays plenty of poached pear, caramelized citrus and some tropical fruit as well as a beautiful acidity, a medium to full-bodied mouthfeel, and a very discreet use of oak. The color is light gold. This is a well-made, medium to full-bodied Chardonnay to drink over the next 7-8 years.
