2014 Sojourn Cellars Wohler Vineyard, Russian River Valley, Pinot Noir

14.2% alc., 500 cases, \$48. This vineyard is located in the heart of the Russian River Valley. Clones are Wädenswil 2A, 115, 667 and "828" planted in Goldridge soil.

Moderate reddish purple hue in the glass. Shy, but pleasing aromas of cherry and sandalwood that pick up intensity over time in the glass. Like cherry pie day at baking class, with a discreetly concentrated core of fresh red cherries and baking spices. Quite elegant and charming, with a silky countenance, weightless tannins, and cherry goodness that hangs on the finish. The lightest weighted wine in the 2014 line up, but one that I liked more and more as I tasted it over time in the glass. It seemed to sneak up on me and give up its charms slowly.
