



**2006 Sojourn Cellars
Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon
Mountain Terraces Vineyard
Sonoma Valley**

Vineyard: This is Audeissa's Estate vineyard planted on the Sonoma side of Mt Veeder from 600 to 1800 feet above sea level.

The Cabernet Sauvignon grapes that went into this offering were sourced from two distinct blocks within this vineyard. The first block is referred to as Phase II and is clone 7 on 110R and was planted in 1992 in rialyte. Phase II is non-terraced, and climbs from 600 to 1400 feet. The second block is referred to as Phase III and is also clone 7 on 110R, but is one year younger than Phase II. Phase III is terraced and climbs from 600 to 1200 feet, but in basalt as opposed to rialyte.

The severity of the terrain, thin soils and southwestern exposure combine to make this an uncommon growing situation for Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon.

Winemaking:

- 100% secondary-sorted Cabernet Sauvignon
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 40% new French oak
- Bottled unfiltered & unfined

- Bottled August 2008 – 140 cases
- AVA: Sonoma Valley
- Alcohol: 15.0%
- pH: 3.79
- TA: 5.2 g/L
