

2007 Sojourn Cellars Pinot Noir Gap's Crown Vineyard Sonoma Coast

Vineyard: Gap's Crown is situated on Roberts Road just above the Sangiacomo Vineyard. This is a high-end, hillside vineyard project that is just coming into its own.

Our fruit came from two distinct blocks within this vineyard. The 828 block was planted in 2002 on 110R at 800 feet elevation. The 115 block was planted in 2005 on 3309 at 1200 feet in extremely rocky soil.

Both of these blocks have pure western exposure and benefit from the cool micro-climate of this site as well as the natural stress created by the severity of the terrain in which our two blocks are located.

Winemaking:

- 100% destemmed Pinot Noir
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 50% new French oak
- Bottled unfiltered & unfined
