



**2007 Sojourn Cellars Pinot Noir
Windsor Oaks Vineyard
Sonoma Coast**

Vineyard: 2007 is the first vintage we have produced a vineyard-designate wine from Windsor Oaks. The vineyard is located near Windsor, CA and benefits from blankets of morning coastal fog tempering lengthy afternoon sun exposure. We have worked with Pinot noir from Windsor Oaks Vineyard for a few years now and it continues to play a key role in our Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir appellation blend.

In 2007, two of the four lots stood out from the others and exceeded expectations, prompting us to bottle this limited release wine. The 115 block has rocky well-draining soils causing the vines to be highly stressed and low-yielding, resulting in a concentrated well-structured lot. The 777 provides luscious texture, deep color, and layers of spice and intense dark cherry flavor components.

Winemaking:

- 100% destemmed Pinot Noir
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 50% new French oak
- Bottled unfiltered & unfined

Bottling:

- Bottled August 2008 – 125 cases
- AVA: Sonoma Coast
- Alcohol: 14.3%
- pH: 3.64
- TA: 5.9 g/L
