



**2008 Sojourn Cellars Pinot Noir
Gap's Crown Vineyard
Sonoma Coast**

Vineyard: Gap's Crown is situated on Roberts Road just above the Sangiacomo Vineyard. This is a high-end, hillside vineyard project that has recently come into its own.

Our fruit comes from blocks planted on 3309 at 1200 feet in extremely rocky soil and perched on the upper peak of the vineyard with pure western exposure. The vineyard benefits from the cool micro-climate of this site as well as the natural stress created by the severity of the terrain.

Winemaking:

- 100% destemmed Pinot Noir
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 50% new French oak
- Bottled unfiltered & unfined
