

SOJOURN CELLARS 2008 CABERNET SAUVIGNON HOME RANCH VINEYARD – SONOMA VALLEY

Vineyard: This vineyard was planted by Craig in 2002 and is located in Craig and Ellen Haserot's "backyard" at the southwestern edge of Sonoma Valley. The clone makeup is 80% clone 337, 10% clone 15, and 10% clone 191 all on 101-14 rootstock. Vineyard spacing is 6 1/2' x 3 ¹/₂' to encourage vine competition. The 2008 vintage is the fourth from this vineyard and the most concentrated to date. Darker aromas of blackberry and cassis present themselves early and lead to classic blueberry aromas with hints of mint that this vineyard consistently produces. The textures are big and lush, with fine grained tannins that linger on the finish.
