



**SOJOURN CELLARS
2008 CABERNET SAUVIGNON
SPRING MOUNTAIN DISTRICT – NAPA VALLEY**

Vineyard: On the upper ridges of Spring Mountain lies the vineyard that produces grapes for this decadent wine. Planted in 1972, the vines are dry farmed and grow on steep southern-facing slopes which produce, along with many of their famous neighbors, concentrated flavors and bold mountain structure. We sourced fruit from two distinct blocks within the vineyard in 2008. The primary block sits in a small bowl with a steep terraced incline, getting plenty of direct sunlight to ripen tannins and flavors. In 2008 we sourced a small amount of Merlot from a second block further up on the ridge to blend with the Cabernet Sauvignon.

Winemaking:

- 86% Secondary-sorted Cabernet Sauvignon
- 14% Secondary-sorted Merlot
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 60% new French oak
- Bottled unfinned and unfiltered
