



SOJOURN CELLARS 2009 PINOT NOIR – SONOMA COAST

Vineyards: This wine is a blend of nine unique blocks primarily from vineyards at the southern end of the Sonoma Coast appellation. Rodgers Creek and Keller Estate vineyards represent the majority of the grapes used to produce this blend. Pinot noir clones 115, 777, 667 and Pommard all add unique elements creating a complex Pinot noir with a myriad of textures and flavors.

- 100% Destemmed Pinot Noir
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 50% new French oak
