



**SOJOURN CELLARS  
2009 CABERNET SAUVIGNON  
HOME RANCH VINEYARD – SONOMA VALLEY**

**Vineyard:** This vineyard was planted by Craig in 2002 and is located in Craig and Ellen Haserot's "backyard" at the southwestern edge of Sonoma Valley. The clone makeup is 80% clone 337, 10% clone 15, and 10% clone 191 all on 101-14 rootstock. Vineyard spacing is 6 1/2' x 3 1/2' to encourage vine competition. The 2009 vintage is the fifth from this vineyard and the most complex so far. Blueberry and dark fruit aromas express themselves early and a hint of mint from the neighboring Eucalyptus adds an element of forest floor. The textures are lush and fine grained tannins linger on the finish.

- 100% Secondary-sorted Cabernet Sauvignon
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 40% new French oak
- Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered
