

SOJOURN CELLARS 2010 PINOT NOIR – SANGIACOMO VINEYARD SONOMA COAST

Vineyard: This vineyard is situated on Roberts Road at the western base of Sonoma Mountain. We sourced fruit from four distinct blocks in 2010. The 115 block was originally planted in 1998 on 101-14 in an old creek bed. The 777 block was planted in 1999 on 101-14 in deeper loam soils. In 2010, we blended small portions of Swan and Pommard clones to add complexity and structural nuances. Climate is key to this vineyard's ability to produce noteworthy Pinot noir. Cool ocean breezes and Petaluma Gap fog keep the heat in check. The cool 2010 vintage provided a long growing season, with flavors maturing at lower average brix and fresh natural acidity.
