

SOJOURN CELLARS 2010 PINOT NOIR – SONOMA COAST

Vineyards: This wine is a blend of eight unique lots produced from Sonoma Coast vineyards ranging from the northern most Annapolis region to the southern Petaluma Gap. Gap's Crown, Sangiacomo, and Keller Estate vineyards represent key elements used to produce this blend. Pinot noir clones 115, Swan, 828, 667, and Pommard add unique characters creating a complex Pinot noir with a myriad of textures and flavors. The 2010 vintage of this wine has a vein of fresh acidity, while maintaining the lush textures from the Gap's Crown and Sangiacomo vineyard components.
