



SOJOURN CELLARS
2010 CABERNET SAUVIGNON
SPRING MOUNTAIN DISTRICT – NAPA VALLEY

Vineyard: We produced the 2010 vintage of our Spring Mountain District Cabernet Sauvignon using grapes sourced from Wurtele Vineyard mid-way up the rugged mountain slopes West of St. Helena. Planted in the early 1990's, the vineyard is comprised of 35 acres planted to 100% clone 7 Cabernet Sauvignon, ranging in elevations from 600 feet to nearly 1000 feet with 360 degrees of exposure and two different soils, volcanic and sedimentary. Our two blocks are situated with southern exposures. One block sits high on a bluff with a modest slope and is trained in the old Geneva Double Curtain method, with the canes sprawling outward exposing the clusters from the top for proper ripening. The second block is on a steep slope of a large bowl and trained VSP double-cordon.

Winemaking:

- 100% Secondary-sorted Cabernet Sauvignon
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 75% new French oak
- Bottled unfinned and unfiltered

- 300 Cases Produced

- TA: 5.9 g/L
