

SOJOURN CELLARS 2011 CABERNET SAUVIGNON RUTHERFORD – NAPA VALLEY

Vineyard: This wine was produced primarily from grapes sourced from Beckstoffer Vineyard Georges III. The vineyard has sandy loam soils with a fair amount of rock from the creek bed scattered throughout. It is the former Beaulieu Vineyard No. 3, which was originally planted by Georges DeLatour of Beaulieu in 1928. The property is located adjacent to the Caymus Winery between Conn Creek Road and Silverado Trail. In 2011, Rutherford Petit Verdot was blended in to add structure and layers of dark fruit to the red fruit core and lush texture of the Georges III Cabernet Sauvignon.
