



SOJOURN CELLARS 2011 PINOT NOIR – SONOMA COAST

Vineyards: This wine is a blend of eight unique lots produced from Sonoma Coast vineyards ranging from the northern most Annapolis region to Occidental to the southern Petaluma Gap. Campbell Ranch, Riddle, Gap's Crown, Sangiacomo, Wohler, and Keller Estate vineyards represent key elements used to produce this blend. Pinot noir clones 115, 828, 667, Pommard, and Wadensville 2A add unique elements creating a complex Pinot noir with a myriad of textures and flavors. The 2011 vintage of this wine is balanced and vibrant with lush textures characteristic of the Gap's Crown and Sangiacomo vineyard components.
