



**SOJOURN CELLARS  
2011 CABERNET SAUVIGNON  
SPRING MOUNTAIN DISTRICT – NAPA VALLEY**

**Vineyard:** The 2011 vintage of our Spring Mountain District Cabernet Sauvignon was produced from grapes grown along the mountain tops above St. Helena. The soils are primarily volcanic and the location is wild, literally. Imagine a drastically varied terrain, extreme slopes, towering redwoods and all the critters and creatures that enjoy living in such extreme conditions. The vines grow on steep southeastern facing slopes that produce concentrated flavors and bold mountain structure. The cool 2011 vintage resulted in a polished wine with pure mountain fruit character with hints of perfume and sweet vanilla from the French oak. It has seamless tension between the acid and fine-grained tannins, providing a lively pallet and good length on the finish.

- Native yeast
- 75% new French oak
- Bottled unfined
