



SOJOURN CELLARS 2012 PINOT NOIR – GAP'S CROWN VINEYARD SONOMA COAST

Vineyard: Gap's Crown is situated on Roberts Road just above the Sangiacomo Vineyard. This is a high-end, hillside vineyard that is gaining acclaim. In 2012, our fruit came from three distinct blocks within this vineyard. The 828 block was planted in 2002 on 110R at 800 feet elevation. The 115 block was planted in 2005 on 3309 at 1200 feet in extremely rocky soil. Both of these blocks have pure western exposure and benefit from the cool micro-climate of this site as well as the natural stress created by the severity of the terrain in which our two blocks are located. The 667 block has a northwest exposure and produces very small berries with dark purple coloring and loads of structure. In 2012, we fermented 10% of the grapes whole-cluster adding to the wine's rich character and aromatic complexity.

- 50% new French oak
