



SOJOURN CELLARS 2012 PINOT NOIR – SONOMA COAST

Vineyards: This wine is a blend of eleven unique lots produced from Sonoma Coast vineyards ranging from the northern most Annapolis region to Occidental and down south to the Petaluma Gap. Campbell Ranch, Riddle, Sangiacomo, Rodgers Creek, and Wohler vineyards represent key components used to produce this blend. Pinot noir clones 115, 828, 667, Pommard, and Swan add unique elements creating a complex Pinot noir with a myriad of textures and flavors. The 2012 vintage of this wine is balanced and vibrant with lush textures characteristic of the Sangiacomo and Rodgers Creek vineyard components.
