

SOJOURN CELLARS 2012 PINOT NOIR – WOHLER VINEYARD RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Vineyards: 2012 was our fourth vintage producing wine from Wohler vineyard near Forestville in the heart of the Russian River Valley appellation. The vineyard was replanted in 2005 – 2006. Young vines of Pinot noir clones 115, 667, and 828 again produced outstanding fruit for us in 2012. Wadensville 2A clone was added to the blend in 2011, and again in 2012, adding more earth and austerity. This wine reflects the renowned terroir of the Goldridge loam soils in this section of the Russian River Valley. This 2012 vintage of Wohler Vineyard Pinot noir shows a more mature complexity and depth and the vineyard continues to prove its potential to produce distinctive Pinot noir.
