

2013 Pinot Noir Silver Eagle Vineyard - Sonoma Coast



THE VINEYARD

Famed vineyard manager Ulises Valdez owns and cares for this Vineyard with an uncommon attention to detail and meticulous farming practices demanded by this extraordinary site. Silver Eagle is a thirty-acre vineyard situated among the rolling hills north of Occidental, in the Green Valley viticulture area, at the western edge of the Sonoma Coast. Sojourn's blocks within the vineyard are positioned in very low-vigor sections and planted in tight formation in Goldridge soils, resulting in small clusters and intense flavors.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2013 growing season began early, with a warm and dry spring, and the weather stayed beautiful through harvest with a moderate heat wave in early September moving the grapes to optimal ripeness. We picked all of our Pinot noir in September for the first time. Dry weather in both winter and spring resulted in smaller berry sizes with robust tannins, detailed aromatics and high concentration levels. In 2013, Pinot noir clones Pommard, Calera and a unique Vosne–Romanee clone were blended together to create this complex wine with intense structure and distinctive character. The Pommard and Calera blocks were picked the same night, while the Vosne–Romanee clone hung for another week and was our last pick from the West Sonoma Coast.
