



2007 Sojourn Cellars Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast

Vineyard: This wine is a blend of grapes sourced from a collection of vineyards all situated in the Sonoma Coast appellation.

The Sullivan Vineyard is a planting of Pommard on 101-14 located on Skagg's Island about ½ mile from the San Francisco Bay. The Fedrick Vineyard is a planting of 777 on 101-14 located on Lakeville Hwy outside Petaluma. The Windsor Oaks Vineyard is a planting of 115, 667 and 777 all on various rootstocks located in Windsor. 777 from the Sangiacomo Vineyard on Roberts Road rounds out the blend.

Winemaking:

- 100% destemmed Pinot Noir
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 50% new French oak
- Bottled unfiltered & unfined

- Bottled August 2008 – 838 cases
- AVA: Sonoma Coast
- Alcohol: 14.3%
- pH: 3.76
- TA: 5.3 g/L
