



**2008 Sojourn Cellars Pinot Noir  
Sangiaco Vineyard  
Sonoma Coast**

**Vineyard:** This vineyard is situated on Roberts Road at the western base of Sonoma Mountain. We source fruit from two distinct blocks. The 115 block was originally planted in 1998 on 101-14 in an old creek bed. The 777 block was planted in 1999 on 101-14 in deeper loam soils.

Climate is key to this vineyard's ability to produce noteworthy Pinot noir. For the 2008 vintage, cool breezes and Petaluma Gap fog allowed the fruit to hang through an early-September heat wave and reach full tannin and flavor maturity. Sugars remained in-check and the vineyard retained appealing natural acidity.

- 100% destemmed Pinot Noir
- Open-top fermentation
- Native yeast
- 50% new French oak
- Bottled unfiltered & unfinned
