



2018 Rosé of Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast



THE VINEYARDS

This wine is a blend of Pinot noir from eight unique Sonoma Coast vineyards ranging from Occidental to the Petaluma Gap. Gap's Crown, Sangiacomo, Reuling, Wohler, Rodgers Creek and Walala Vineyards represent key components used to produce this rosé.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2018 vintage was mild and dry, allowing the fruit on the vine to mature beautifully. There were no prolonged heat spells, allowing picking decisions to be made with ease. It was one of the latest harvests in recent memory, with moderate fruit yields providing an abundance of flavor. The resulting wines are noted for racy acidity and expressive fruit. We were impressed with the robust flavors, rich character, and balanced structure across all varietals in the 2018 vintage. The Rosé of Pinot noir was harvested at night and is a blend of saignée and pressed wine. The juice was fermented at low temperatures to maintain delicate aromatics and fresh fruit character.
