

2019 Rosé of Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast



THE VINEYARDS

This wine is a blend of Pinot noir from eight unique Sonoma Coast vineyards ranging from Occidental to the Petaluma Gap. Gap's Crown, Sangiacomo, Reuling, Wohler, Rodgers Creek and Walala Vineyards represent key components used to produce this rosé.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2019 vintage was similar to 2018 in that the mild season allowed for long and slow maturation. The lack of major heat waves and virtually no rain during harvest allowed us to pick every vineyard block at optimal ripeness. The 2019 vintage was slightly lower yielding, which resulted in even greater concentration in the wines. Balanced structures and rich flavors can be expected from the 2019 vintage wines. This Rosé of Pinot noir is a blend of saignée juice and pressed wine. The grapes were hand-harvested in the cold of night. Fermentation was performed in tank at very low temperatures and lasted almost 3 months. The resulting rosé is elegant and vibrant.
