93 Points - 2020 Sangiacomo Vineyard Chardonnay

Bold and harmonious, delivering tropical mango, pineapple and ripe peach flavors that are generous and juicy. Offers terrific purity and freshness, with vibrant acidity and hints of anise and grey salt, which linger on the finish.

92 Points - 2020 Durell Vineyard Chardonnay

A mouthwatering, crisp frame sets up the foundation for aromatic and precise Honeycrisp apple, lemon sherbet, lemon verbena and lemon thyme on the long finish.

92 Points - 2020 Reuling Vineyard Chardonnay

This offers flavors of spiced baked apple that show hints of nutmeg and clove on a sleek, juicy frame that carries the weight and richness effortlessly, with hints of buttery pastry and lighter, fresher accents of crisp lemon, yuzu and grated ginger.

92 Points - 2019 Home Ranch Cuvée Cabernet Sauvignon

This has a nice caressing feel, despite the weight, with cassis, boysenberry and raspberry preserves rolling through and carried by ample but polished grip. The finish lets sparkles of anise and fruitcake peek through. Pretty tasty.

90 Points - 2020 Sonoma Coast Chardonnay

Creamy and rich, with creamy salted butter notes up front and a touch of vanilla anglaise to complement the apricot pastry, lemon curd and citrus zest notes that show a juicy thread of acidity.
