



## 2023 ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR SONOMA COAST



**THE VINEYARD** This wine is a blend of Pinot Noir from eight unique Sonoma Coast vineyards, ranging from Annapolis in the far north to the Petaluma Gap in the south. New in 2023, we included pressed grapes from our Sasaki Estate Vineyard. Sasaki was originally planted in 1974 to Martini clone on St. George rootstock. The soils are clay loam, and the site stays cool and windy during the growing season. Gap's Crown, Silver Eagle and Walala Vineyards represent other key components used to produce this Rosé.

**WINEMAKER NOTES** 2023 brought an end to several years of drought in California, with ample rains during the winter months. Colder temperatures delayed budbreak, and the vines woke up later than usual. Moderate spring and summer temperatures followed, allowing the grapes to ripen evenly and develop complex flavors with mature tannins. Harvest began two weeks later than average in the Sonoma Coast, and yields were plentiful. This Rosé of Pinot Noir is a blend of saignée juice and pressed wine. Fermentation was performed in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures over three months, and the wine was cold stabilized before bottling. The resulting Rosé is dry and aromatic in a more Provençal style, with vibrant acidity and minerality.
